Member Risks & Responsibilities			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tools borrowed from the Southeast Seattle Tool Library ("SESTL") may only be used by the Primary Member and/or the Secondary Member identified above. • The tools in our collection have sharp edges; moving blades; abrasive materials; protruding ends; heated components; electrical currents; rapidly spinning bits and shafts; high-pressure components; and other hazardous characteristics. If proper precautions are not taken, the tools or the objects on which the tools are used may injure or even kill the user or bystanders. • The operation of any tool can result in foreign objects being thrown into eyes, which can result in severe eye damage. When using a tool, always wear safety goggles or glasses with side shields and, when appropriate, a full face shield. • Position cords, hoses, clothing, jewelry, hair, and other materials so they do not get caught on lumber, tools or other obstructions while working. Failure to do so can result in serious personal injury or death. • Some dust created by sanding, sawing, grinding, drilling, and other tool-related activities contains chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm. Some examples of these chemicals are: lead from lead-based paints, crystalline silica from bricks and cement and other masonry products; and arsenic and chromium from chemically-treated lumber. Members can reduce exposure to these chemicals by working in a well ventilated area and using approved safety equipment. • Members are responsible for educating themselves about proper use of the tools and for using all appropriate safety gear (safety glasses, gloves, ear protection, etc.). By signing this form, Members acknowledge that any guidance provided by the SESTL is incomplete and may contain inaccuracies. Members also acknowledge that the SESTL makes no representations about the fitness of its tools for any particular task. • SESTL Members must be 18 years of age or above. SESTL discourages the presence of minors on the SESTL premises due to the risk of injury. All minors on the SESTL premises must be accompanied and supervised by a SESTL Member at all times. Any SESTL Member accompanying a minor onto the SESTL premises assumes all responsibility for the supervision of the accompanied minor at all times to ensure their safety and well-being. • It is the Member's responsibility to inspect and confirm the safe working condition of each tool prior to borrowing and using it. • MEMBERS ASSUME ALL RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH USE OF THE TOOLS. • Borrowed tools must be cleaned before they are returned. Please report any damage or malfunction immediately to SESTL staff. • All loans are for a seven-day period unless otherwise specified. Loan status can be checked at https://setools.myturn.com. • By signing this form, each Member affirms they have read and fully understand the rules and regulations of the SESTL and understand that failure to comply with any of these rules, failure to return tools in a timely manner, or engaging in disrespectful or threatening behavior may result in revocation of a Member's borrowing privileges and legal action where appropriate.
