



## Donation Guidelines

Thank you for thinking of the Southeast Seattle Tool Library for your tool donations! While we greatly appreciate donations, here are just a few things you should know before donating:

- We need to be selective about what we accept due to limited space.
- For large tools, please email [info@setools.org](mailto:info@setools.org) with make and model details and photos if possible, to make sure it fits our space and our members' needs.

### Our basic acceptance criteria for tools are:

- They turn on and work as expected.
- They include all necessary parts and accessories.
- If we have many versions of this same tool already, the donation is better than our lowest quality one.
- There is no serious damage / rust / excess sharpening or maintenance needed.
- Our members are likely to use them.
- We have space to store them.

### We do not accept:

- Any gas powered tools.** Our insurance does not permit us to store or loan them.
- Tools that use NiCad batteries.** Note that older Ridgid and Ryobi tools that originally used NiCad batteries work with Lithium batteries, so we are happy to take them and recycle any NiCad batteries you wish to donate with them.
- Chainsaws and radial arm saws**, for safety reasons.
- Supplies** such as nails, grout, paint, roof shingles, etc. as we have no room to store them.
